

MICRO-MARKET VENDING SERVICES RFP QUESTIONS:

- 1.) How many people are working at the site, full time at least 4 days per week that will have access to the market? **There are an estimated 75-100 people per day, who utilize the Joint Health Sciences Center. The Joint Health Sciences Center is a biomedical research facility and academic building.**
- 2.) Do students occupy this area? If so, what is the estimated count? **Students do not occupy A100; however, the room is available to all Joint Health Sciences Center building tenants. Existing tenants include faculty, staff and students from Rowan University, Rutgers-Camden Center for Computational and Integrative Biology, Camden County College Allied Health Programs, the Cooper Medical School of Rowan University along with Administrative Offices of Rowan University/Rutgers-Camden Board of Governors. Room A100 is available for scheduling meetings. Otherwise, the space is open to faculty, staff and students for general use if the room not reserved for a meeting or class.**
- 3.) Who will have access to the market? Employees only? General Public? **All tenants will have access to the market, including facilities management and janitorial staff. General Public will not have access to the market.**
- 4.) After “hours,” will the market area be secured (i.e.) locked? **Yes, the market area will be secured after hours; however, faculty researchers and graduate students have access to the building during off hours to check on experiments. They will have access to the Micro-Market through the swipe card system.**
- 5.) Are there any other competing food/drink sources in the building such as:
 - a. Vending Machines? **No**
 - b. Cafés? **No**
 - c. Food Kiosks? **No**
 - d. Coffee Shops? **No**
 - e. Food Trucks? **Yes; Food Trucks are “only” engaged on a seasonal basis, and will be on site one day per week in the Spring and Fall.**
