

RFP 2022-06 STRATEGIC PLANNING CONSULTANT QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

1. The RFP seeks a consultant to work with staff and prepare a strategic plan. The RFP offers a timeline of a one year period, with, at the Board's sole discretion, the possibility of two one year extensions. Has the Board and/or administration identified a budget or estimate of costs for the retention of such a qualified consultant and, if so, what is the estimated amount for that purpose? **Yes. The Adopted FY23 Budget includes a line item for hiring consultants to assist the Board with campus planning, urban design concepts, strategic planning and commissioned studies which impact and improve the social determinants of health.**
2. Does the Board have a Master Plan for development of the "eds and meds" corridor? **The Rowan University/Rutgers-Camden Board of Governors adopted a Health Sciences Campus Plan during its Executive Session on October 28, 2016. The Campus Plan provided an overview for a phased plan for development of the Health Sciences Campus located within the Eds and Meds corridor at Broadway and MLK Blvd. The Joint Board completed Phase I and II and is presently undertaking the planned development of Phase III. The Campus Plan is currently being updated and should be aligned to a 5-year strategic plan tied to the Board's statutory mandate, mission and three objectives.**
